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**Measures of Student Achievement**

In Academic Year 2019-20, eight students submitted capstone projects. The reports were reviewed by a faculty committee who rated each according to the adopted SUP criteria. Each category was scored on a 1-5 scale with 5 being the highest score. 95% of students scored 4-5 in the written and communication skills category while 90% scored a 4 or 5 in demonstrating a broad-based knowledge of sustainability. 100% of students scored a 5 on the ability to form evidence-based policy while 96% of capstones demonstrated an ability to apply planning theory to practice and 100% were judged to have demonstrate an understanding of professional ethics.
